

# Intoxica

**Social conditions** 73% of the Intoxica 2009 collection was produced in The Netherlands and Portugal, which is classified into the low-risk country category (Class A). The remaining 27% was produced in a factory in China, and this factory has been working on getting compliant to the BSCI standard.

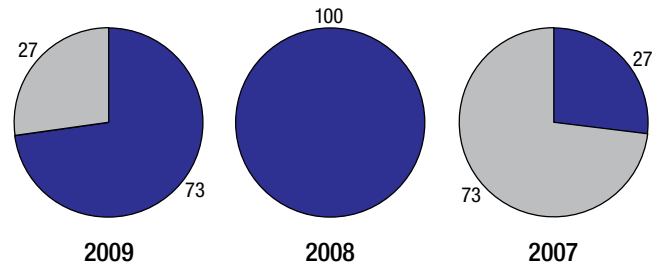
**Environmental conditions** 77% of Intoxica's 2009 collection was made of cotton, and 85% of this cotton collection was produced with organic cotton (Class B). The decline of the Class B score can be explained by the fact that in 2009 Intoxica produced their collection with less cotton fabric, and instead they produced more items made of silk. The usage of silk increased the score of the 'unclassified' category in the raw materials scorecard. As soon as sufficient information regarding silk fibre becomes available, it will be included in the MADE-BY Environmental Benchmark for Fibres.

Meanwhile, in 2009, Intoxica produced a jacket line made of recycled polyester (Class A) and increased the usage of linen and ramie (Class C).

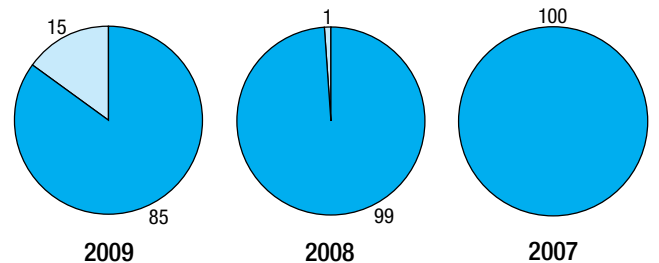

% of total cotton collection

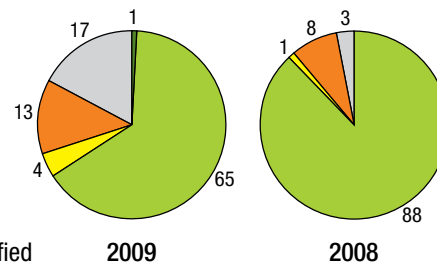
- organic / in conversion
