

# MakeZenz

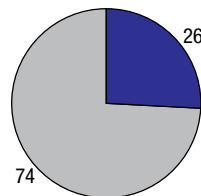
**Social conditions** In 2009 MakeZenz focused on suppliers in China, Turkey and Poland. Production in a low risk country such as Poland represents 26% of their total production. The remaining 74% score unclassified because the social status of both the Turkish and the Chinese factory is unknown.

**Environmental conditions** As an organic fashion pioneer in Denmark, MakeZenz focuses on using organic cotton as much as possible in their collections. In 2009 they sourced various fabrics and blends containing organic cotton which resulted in an overall usage of 91% of organic cotton (Class B) compared to all cotton used in their collection. MakeZenz used a very small percentage of conventional cotton, bamboo viscose and polyester. The remaining 12% shown as unclassified represent fibres such as silk and cashmere.

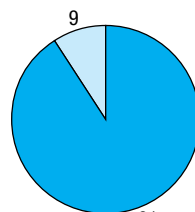

- conventional

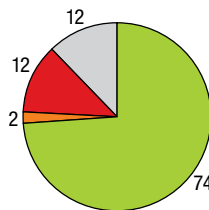
