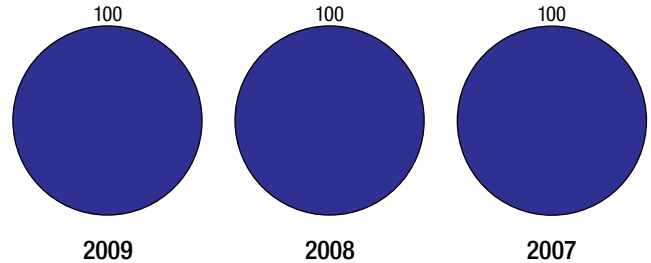
Social conditions 100% Organic Cotton produced its collection for 2009 with Indian suppliers which have implemented good social practices. All of these suppliers are SA8000 certified which is benchmarked as Class A. All of the styles which were produced in 2009 are traceable via the MADE-BY Track and Trace online consumer tool. www.made-by.org

Environmental conditions In 2009, 100% Organic Cotton produced its entire collection with organic cotton, hereby staying committed to their core philosophy. A very low percentage of other fibres were used as a couple of organic cotton styles were blended with viscose or lycra to add more stretch. Much of the organic cotton was from the Chetna project in India, which was set up by Solidaridad. Good environmental practices, working conditions and fair prices (Fairtrade certified) for the farmers have been implemented into this project.

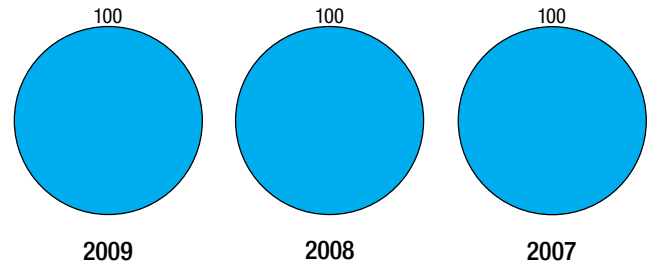

% of total cotton collection

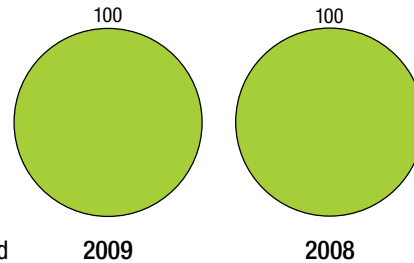
- organic / in conversion
