

Rianne de Witte

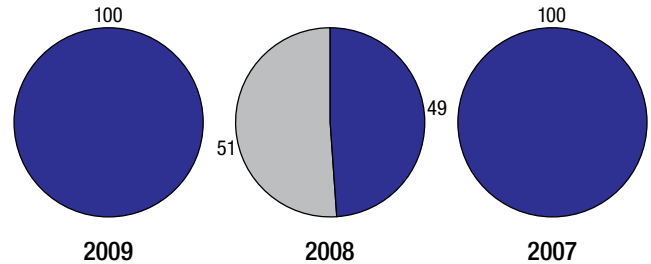
Social conditions Rianne de Witte produced the entire 2009 collection in Portugal, which is classified as a low risk country category (Class A). This is an increase of 51% from the previous year. From the outset, Rianne de Witte has taken into account the social conditions in its choice of suppliers, and therefore aimed to place the majority of their orders with factories located in low risk countries.

Environmental conditions Rianne de Witte 2009 collection consisted mainly of organic cotton and Tencel® (sustainable alternative for viscose). Both materials, which are counted as 98% of the collection, fall under Class B in the MADE-BY Environmental Benchmark for Fibres. The high usage of these materials has led to a significant increase of the Class B; from 31% to 98%. In addition, the entire cotton collection in 2009 was produced with organic cotton.

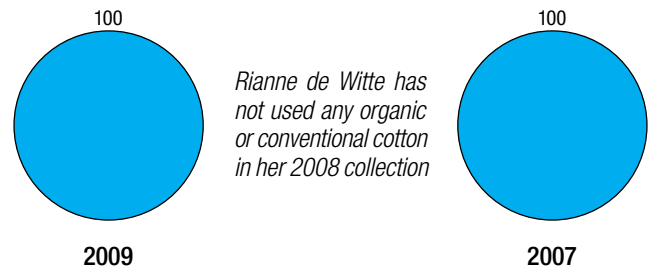

% of total cotton collection

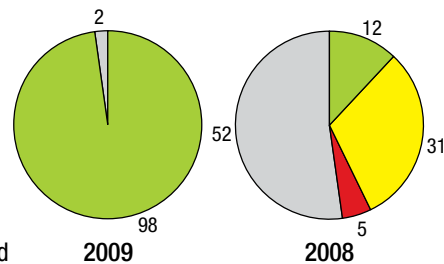
- organic / in conversion
