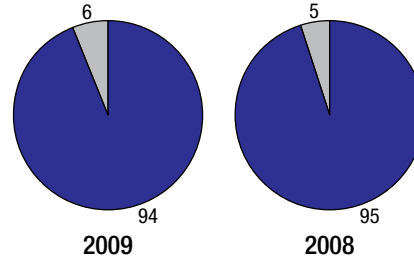
Social conditions Slippely has a solid base of suppliers, which they have worked with for more than 10 years. In 2009 they managed to have as much as 94% of its collection produced in Portugal, which falls under the category of a low-risk country (Class A) in the MADE-BY Benchmark for Social Standards.

Environmental conditions Slippely has successfully produced a large share of its collection from organic cotton. In 2009, 45% of their collection consisted of cotton, with 97% of it made with organic cotton (Class B). The main focus for 2010 is to replace viscose (Class E) with Tencel® (Class B), which is the second most used material accounting for 43% of the total 2009 collection.

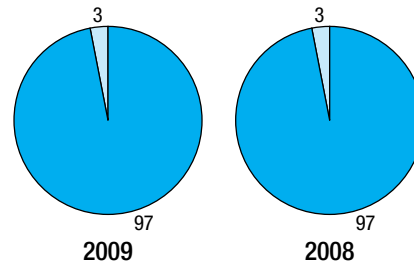

% of total cotton collection

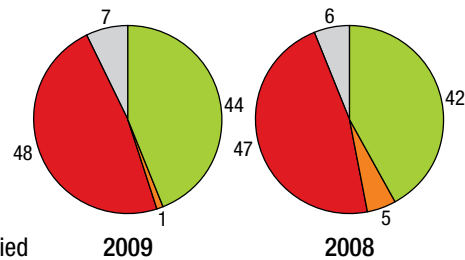
- organic / in conversion
